Definitions Montana Professional Development Rules		
PIR (Pupil Instruction Related)	Montana Code 20-1-304. A pupil-instruction-related day is a day of teacher activities devoted to improving the quality of instruction. The activities may include but are not limited to inservice training, attending state meetings of teacher organizations, and conducting parent conferences. A maximum of 7 pupil-instruction-related days may be conducted during a school year, with a minimum of 3 of the days for instructional and professional development meetings or other appropriate inservice training, if the days are planned in accordance with the policy adopted by the board of public education. The days may not be included as a part of the required minimum aggregate hours of pupil instruction.	
	If a certified staff member misses a scheduled PIR day, they will need to make up 6 hours of PIR as arranged with their supervisor.	
Flexible PIR	To fulfill their yearly MCPS contract, certified staff are required to complete 12 hours/credits of flexible PIR professional learning between June 1st and the fourth Friday of May. These hours may be completed in October by attending the MFPE Educator Conference or by completing courses outside of contract hours. Flexible PIR is DIFFERENT from the district led PIR days that are already part of the contracted days.	
Salary Advancement Credit (SAD):	Some professional learning courses will offer SAD credit. SAD credit is similar in rigor to earning college graduate credit and offered specifically through MCPS for potential horizontal movement on the salary schedule. SAD credits are non-transferable to other districts and pay scales.	
OPI Renewal Units	OPI renewal units are required for licensure renewal through the Montana Office of Public Instruction. Most licenses require 60 OPI units every five years for license renewal. Semester/quarter college credits can be converted to OPI renewal units (1 semester credit = 15 OPI units or 1 quarter credit = 10 renewal units). MCPS is an approved provider for OPI renewal units and can offer this concurrently with some mandatory PIR days as well as for all Flex PIR opportunities.
