Dear Battle of the Books Families,

The MCPS Battle of the Books is an optional enrichment activity provided at most MCPS elementary and middle schools. Practices often occur during school hours and book titles are available for participating students to check out in the school library. Students may join a team and can divide the titles to be read between their team members. Individual students are not required to read all titles to participate in Battle of the Books; reading all book titles is optional for both individuals and teams.

As an organized school function where the library provides the books to be read, we notify families of all book titles in compliance with SB99. SB99 requires notification of human sexuality instruction, which is defined as “teaching or otherwise providing information about human sexuality, including intimate relationships, human sexual anatomy, sexual reproduction, sexually transmitted infections, sexual acts, sexual orientation, gender identity, abstinence, contraception, or reproductive rights and responsibilities.”

Parent/Guardian permission is required for students to participate in the 2024-2025 Battle of the Books.
