

Missoula County Public Schools Executive Summary Input on Drafts of Core Purpose, Core Values, Long-Term Envisioned Future and MegaTrends Analysis

The following is an Executive Summary of the on-line survey responses from staff, parents, and community members on the following DRAFT components of the District's Strategic Plan: Core Purpose, Core Values, Long-Term Envisioned Future and MegaTrends Analysis. This information will be helpful in establishing the 3-5 year priorities and the 1-2 strategies to be discussed during the planning meeting of April 20, 2021.

Levels of Participation

The on-line survey yielded **355 responses** with 92.96% (330) of the responses from parents, 4.51% (16) responses from certified staff, 1.13% (4) responses from classified staff, 1.13% (4) responses from community members who don't have children in the District and .28% (1) from the student population.
